Kindles for the Classroom will individualize and improve classroom instruction and increase student learning and engagement through technology.

Description of Need

Is your goal to supplement an existing curriculum or to address a prevalent student need? Tell us why this project or idea is needed and who it will primarily serve.

My goal is to give my ELL students access to a broader spectrum of vocabulary through the use of individualized Kindle applications geared towards improving skills in reading, writing, and understanding the content areas. In their book, *Meaningful Differences in the Everyday Experiences of Young American Children* (1995), Hart and Risley state, “by age 3 the children in professional families would have heard more than 30 million words, the children in working class families 20 million, and the children in welfare families 10 million”. Students from low-income families are part of the at-risk population who have heard fewer words and as a result have not sufficiently developed cognitively in comparison to children from middle and high class families. Research supports the need for these students to have extra resources as a means to ‘level the playing field’ of standardized testing.

Learning a second language is a personal journey and moves at the pace of the individual learner. I believe my ELL students need and deserve extra resources, because not only are my students learning a second language, but they are also from low-income households. These two factors can put my students at a severe disadvantage in the classroom and hinder any future success. In addition to the afore-mentioned disadvantages, several if not all of my students come from a home where at least one parent is unable to speak English.

Goals and Objectives

My goal is to provide students with individual tablets as to allow them to interact with text to practice and demonstrate reading comprehension. Students will be given access to various content areas that interest them and further encourage language acquisition. Students will be able to track lines of text more easily. Students will be able to organize thoughts visually as well as audibly using dictation which will allow students to brainstorm ideas orally and thus not lose ideas before they can be written. With the use of various applications students will have access to math manipulatives and other interactive software as to build their abilities to compute basic math facts.
