



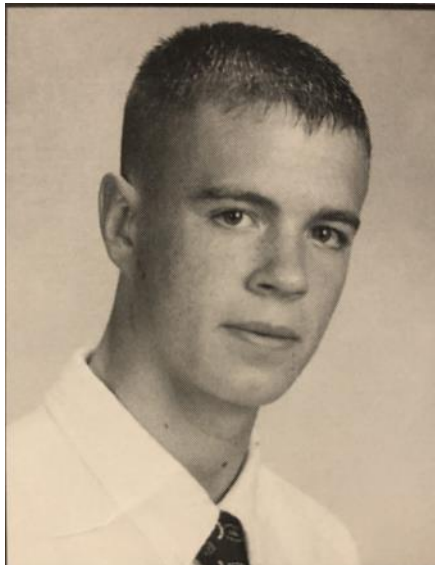
2022 Inductee: Achievements in Athletics

Jay Boyle '00

Gerard "Jay" Boyle III had an outstanding four-year varsity career that culminated in an extraordinary senior season in which he and his teammates won 18 consecutive games (the longest winning streak in the school's history), finished with a regular season record of 19 wins and 1 loss, captured the Middlesex League Championship (for the first time since 1981), qualified for state tournament play for the second consecutive season, reached the North Sectional quarter-finals, finished with an overall record of 20 wins and 2 losses, and ended the season ranked 17th in the Boston Globe's Eastern Massachusetts Final Top 20 Poll.

For his efforts, Jay was named to the Alf-Middlesex League team (for the third time in his career), a Boston Herald All-Scholastic, a McDonald's All-American nominee, a "Best 80" Game participant, and the Daily Times Chronicle's Outstanding Winter Sports Performer (he'd twice previously received honorable mention).

Jay graduated as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,369 career points — ahead of Hall of Fame members Ron Hobby and Ed Foley — and held numerous other single-game, single season, and career records. We are proud to induct him for athletic achievement into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
