



## **2022 Inductee: Contributions to Athletics**

### **Coach Robert “Bob” Doran**

Bob served the Woburn Public Schools from 1963 to 1997 as a teacher and as Chair of the English Department, and coached JV Basketball for 8 years. He is being inducted into the Woburn Hall of Fame in honor of his leadership and success as Woburn’s Varsity Golf Coach for 39 years, during which time the team won 21 Middlesex League Titles, 5 Division North Titles, advanced to State Finals 14 times and were Division II State Champions 3 out of 4 years. His record as Coach stands at 321-91-10.

Bob was honored as Middlesex League Coach of the Year and Boston Globe’s Coach of the Year in 1999. In 2011, the Middlesex League Coaches voted to name the League’s Most Valuable Player of the Year (MVP) in his honor, as “The Bob Doran MVP Award.”

Bob retired as Coach in 2011. He passed away in December 2019. His legacy is part of the esteemed history of Woburn Athletics, and we are proud to honor his important contributions as a Coach and inductee into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
