Charles “Chuck” Greene

Charles “Chuck” Greene is the founder of Woburn’s Pop Warner Football. After years of research to find out how to get things done, and work that involved countless phone calls, and travels both near and far, in January of 1959 Chuck realized his dream to bring youth football to the City of Woburn. The first members of the Woburn Trojans took the field in the fall of 1960. In those early years Chuck served as Head Coach of the Trojans as well as the first treasurer of the Woburn Pee Wee Association, and was part of the leadership that built the foundation of Woburn Pop Warner, making the program what it is today—a source of community pride that engages hundreds of boys and girls in team play based on sportsmanship, love of the game and fun!

While building the Woburn football program, Chuck also joined Woburn Little League as a coach. It was his spirit of fair play and sportsmanship that broke the long-standing practice of coaches only playing their “best nine”. Today, all players in Woburn’s Little League Program regardless of their stats or skills, play at least 2 innings of every game, thanks to the efforts of Chuck Greene.

For his contributions to Woburn’s Youth Sports Programs, we are proud to induct Charles “Chuck” Greene into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
