

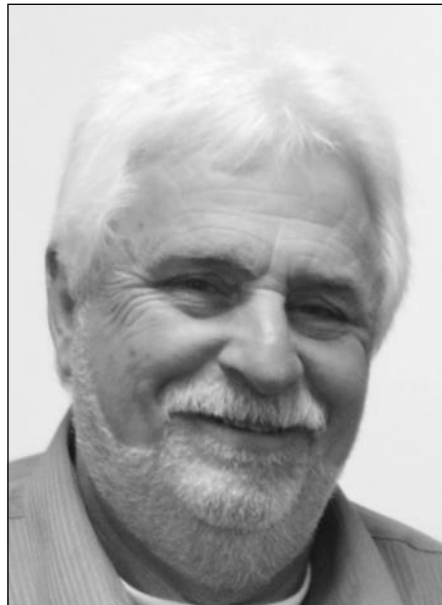


2022 Inductee: Distinguished Alumnus

John Flaherty '74

John Flaherty is a successful businessman committed to making his hometown a better place. As President of ADA Solutions (now retired), he holds a number of patents and led the growth of the organization, now the largest provider of detectable warning tiles in the world. When introduced to the market, these products were a game changer for the visually impaired, dramatically improving their mobility, independence and quality of life. In recent years John has used the proceeds from his successful business to honor and preserve Woburn history and to support Tanner Pride.

His personal philanthropy includes donations to support Woburn Memorial High School, fully funding the ramp construction necessary to make the Press Box at Connolly Stadium ADA compliant. He also paid for the school's new tennis courts, asking that they be named in honor of long-time WMHS Vice Principal James F. Brennan. John also covered all expenses associated with the Woburn Veterans War Memorial in Woburn Common, and has purchased several historic properties in the area, preserving their beauty and integrity for future generations. For his business success, philanthropic leadership, and obvious commitment to Woburn residents, both past and present, we are proud to induct John Flaherty as a distinguished alumnus into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
