**Woburn High School Soccer
2000 Championship Team**

Coached by Hall of Fame inductee Peter Hantzis, this team was the 2000 MIAA Division 2 State Champions. Finishing the season at the top of Boston Globe's soccer rankings, beating out even Division 1 Schools, the team went 16-0-2 in the regular season and 22-0-2 overall. The team dominated the field both offensively and defensively, allowing only 11 goals during the regular season, while scoring 59. The players were known for their agility and speed, for their character and chemistry and for their sportsmanship and integrity.

The 2000 Boys Soccer Team was the first and is the only team in Tanners history to win a state title. We are proud to honor the achievements of the 2000 Woburn High Soccer Team as inductees into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
