Tom Cole '88

In hockey, goal tending can make or break a team. Tom Cole, as a skilled and talented net-minder, helped the Tanner teams secure a spot in the D1 state tournament every year he played. A Middlesex League MVP and First Team Boston Globe and Boston Herald All-Scholastic, Tom was also a member of the USA Select U17 Hockey Team and a Hockey Night in Boston (HNIB) Defensive Player of the Year.

Tom went on to play for Northeastern University, and was between the pipes during Beanpot Tournament play on February 4, 1991, stopping 51 of 56 shots vs. Boston College. Though BC would ultimately win, Tom's performance is widely considered among the best in Beanpot history. That year Tom was awarded the Eberly Award, given annually to the goalie with the best save percentage.

In 1988 Tom was drafted in the 9th round, 187th overall by the Edmonton Oilers. He played in semi-pro hockey for several years. We are proud to induct Tom Cole into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
