


## 2024 Inductee: Distinguished Alumnus

James J. Foley '52

James "Jim" Foley was a true-blue Woburnite who found personal and professional success and fulfillment in the city he loved so much. As an educator at Woburn High School, he advanced from the classroom to administration, becoming one of the first Headmasters at Woburn High, and ultimately Principal in 1981, a position he held for thirteen years. As a young man with a growing family, Jim became involved in school sports as a coach in basketball and referee in football. His involvement in refereeing continued throughout his life, at many levels up through Division I, and included instructing and teaching refereeing skills for the New England organization.

Jim was dedicated to his profession and the to success of Woburn High School and was well-respected by teachers and students alike. His love of Woburn inspired the same in his students, and this undoubtedly inspired many of the Woburn leaders of today.
