



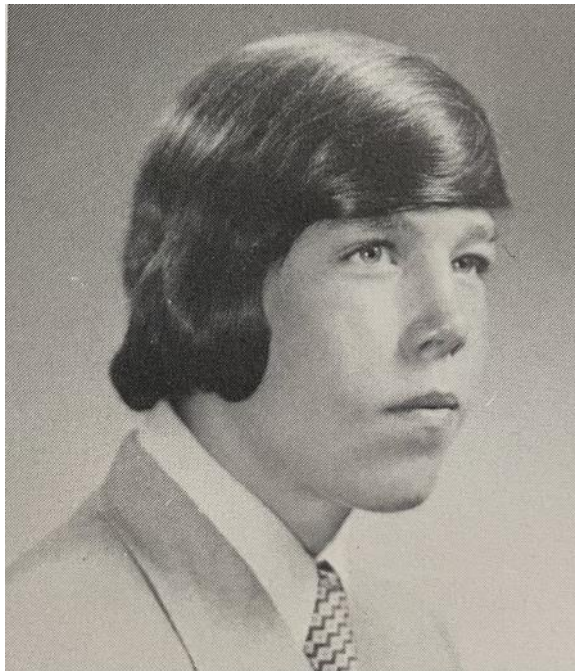
2024 Inductee: Distinguished Alumnus

James L. "Jamie" McKeown '73

Jamie McKeown was a family man and community leader who was taken much too soon. After a short stint as a classroom teacher, Jamie joined Cummings Properties in 1979, rising to become its second-ever president before the age of 35. He mentored numerous colleagues throughout his tenure, and remained dedicated to providing opportunities for young people to advance their capacity for leadership.

Jamie was the driving force behind the expansion of Cummings Properties in the 1990's, including the Cummings Business Center in Beverly, now a MetroNorth landmark. He also held many leadership roles in the community, including treasurer of the Woburn Industrial Finance Authority and president of the Woburn Business Association (WBA), now the Woburn Chamber of Commerce. A former "Boy of the Year" at the Woburn Boys Club, he went on to become the first alumnus elected director and its youngest president. This Woburn institution, as well as many others across the state, now bear his name.

Jamie led by example and had an unwavering commitment to "doing the right thing". In honor of his leadership and integrity, and the many personal qualities that earned him the admiration and respect of all who knew him, we are proud to induct James L. "Jamie" McKeown as a distinguished alumnus into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
