



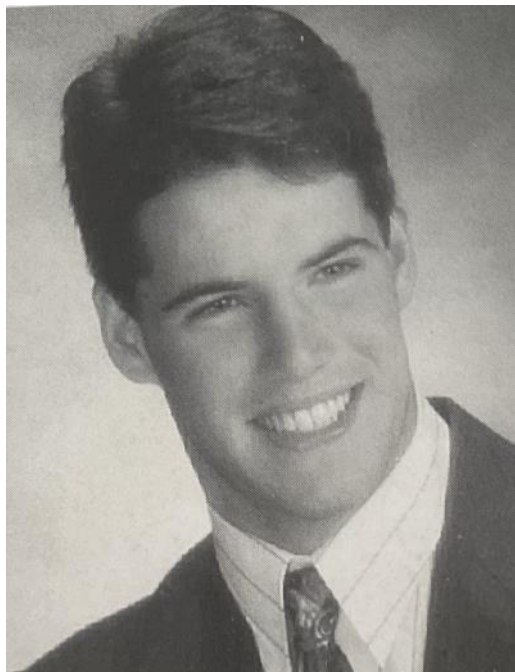
2024 Inductee: Athlete

Michael Wall '94

Michael Wall played halfback for Tanner Football from 1991-1993. Team captain his senior year, Mike had 1,878 rushing yards, 22 touchdowns and a single game rushing record of 278 yards. His 142 points made him second in Eastern MA, and he boasted four 200 yard rushing games. Mike's 2,245 career rushing yards was a school record.

In 1992 Mike was Boston Globe All-Scholastic, Middlesex League All-Star, and winner of both the Knowlton Award and the Shamrock Award. His senior year he was Boston Globe All-Scholastic (Globe Super Team), Boston Herald All-Scholastic, Middlesex League Player of the Year, and winner (again) of the Knowlton and Shamrock Awards. In 1993 he played in the Shriners All-Star game.

In 2007 Mike was keynote speaker at the annual Rotary Luncheon leading up to the Woburn-Winchester Thanksgiving Day game. In true Tanner fashion, he reminded the student-athletes that in sports and in life it's "all about hard work—there are no shortcuts". In honor of his talents, his work ethic, and his contributions to Tanner Pride, we induct Michael Wall into the Woburn Hall of Fame.
